

- 5B. **SUNNYSIDE BRIDGE SKETCH PLANS:** Scott Allen, Engineer McCormick Taylor, outlined the proposed single span alternative for the bridge on Sunnyside Road. Discussion followed on putting a sidewalk on one side of the bridge. Scott Allen will get back to the Board of Supervisors on this issue. The present sketch plan shows two lanes of twelve foot each. The bridge would be sixty-feet long. It would have three steel beams. To place a sidewalk on side of bridge would require another beam.
- 5C. **RED ROOF FARM PRELIMINARY LAND DEVELOPMENT:** Scott Allen, Township Engineer, stated a memorandum dated March 27, 2008 was sent to D.L. Howell Engineer for the Red Roof Farm. Based on this memorandum, the application and related materials are to be returned. Scott Allen will contact D.L. Howell to pick-up the material.
- 6A. **WEBSITE COST:** Robin went over the cost of the website and asked for the Board permission to get a new web provider. Victor Mantegna made a motion to approve Crystal Tech as the provider for the Web. Seconded by Curtis Mason – all in favor. Robin stated that the office staff would be schooled in the new requirements for the web. When Vince Sammons of VSS Computer Consulting reviews the material, this information will be forwarded to the supervisors.
- Victor Mantegna made a motion that any Committee Assignments in the future for the Supervisors material necessary should go to that supervisors in charge of the assignment when he asked for that material. Seconded by Robin Marcello – all in favor.
- 6B. **CCIU – Drainage Issue:** Joseph Lubitsky, Director of Administrative Services for Chester County Intermediate Unit was present. Discussion followed on David Moore's problem off Pennocks Bridge Road. Curtis Mason asked Scott Allen, Engineer for the Township, "What Was Being Done To Correct the Problem of Erosion at the Moore Property?" Scott stated that he felt when the job is complete; the sedimentation problem will work properly. At the present, a higher rate of discharge is flowing. To slow this discharge down, Scott suggested that riprap be added to the swale to dam up and cause the water to flow at a slower rate. Also, sedimentation needs to be cleaned out of the basin.
- 7A. **SPRING NEWSLETTER:** Curtis Mason asked that the Board of Supervisors take a look over the newsletter material furnished. Also, if anyone would like to add something, contact Carla Lucas at Lucas Communications & Publications.
- 7B. **WOODCHIP PROPOSAL:** Victor Mantegna made a motion to approve the proposal from George Ely Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$2,927.00 to add the wood carpet to the play areas. Seconded by Robin Marcello – all in favor.

Victor Mantegna asked to have the Jenners Commons Engineering letters from R.E. Coleman in reference to the road entrance be made available for the supervisors.

Discussion on road bank mowing. Curtis stated he would like to see the same proposal advertised as was used last year. Mowing road bank one time and then use retardant immediately following the cutting. Skip Elvin stated he would like to see the mowing done two times. The Board of Supervisors agreed with the suggestion made by Curtis.

Victor Mantegna made a motion to adjourn the meeting.
