<u>Call to Order</u>: Board Chair Mantegna called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. immediately after the adjournment of the annual reorganization meeting.

- <u>Approve Meeting Minutes/Approve invoices/Treasurer's report</u>: Supervisor Sperratore made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the regular meeting on December 1, 2021, approve invoices and the treasurer's report. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. All in favor.

- <u>4.</u> <u>Planning Commission Report:</u> Scott Steele reported the planning commission would be recommending approval with conditions for the Casa Carmen Winery at the Hood Farm. Chair Steele stated that this would be an asset to the community and the Planning Commission letter would be presented to the Board at the Jan. 19 conditional use hearing.

A subsequent motion was made by Supervisor O'Connell to give the sewer line to AQUA for the purpose of providing sewer service to 13 Rosewood Drive. Seconded by Supervisor Sperratore. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0. Both motions were subject to approval by the township solicitor and documents could be signed outside of a public meeting.
