- 10.MS4 Township Engineer Dennis O'Neill discussed the impending MS4 requirements for Penn Township imposed by DEP. He presented an opportunity to partner with PennDOT via a contract they awarded to Resource Environmental Solutions (RES) of King of Prussia which would allow Penn to implement the mandatory TMDI reduction in urbanized areas for a fraction of the cost Penn would have to pay if these reductions were pursued individually. The cost per pound quoted was \$1.95. This effort would focus only on the Big Elk which is on the Chesapeake Bay side of the township. O'Neill requested the Board permit him to open a dialogue with RES. Supervisor Mantegna made a motion directing the Township Engineer to proceed. Seconded by Supervisor O'Connell. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- <u>11. Road vacation --</u> Supervisor Mason made a motion to direct the solicitor to officially begin the process to vacate Hood Road. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
