Avon Grove Library Penn Representative Suzanne Regnier and Executive Director Lori Schwabenbauer thanked the Board for Penn's support of the library and co-sponsoring of events such as movies. Requested the same level of funding or better for 2021 as Penn has the highest number of cardholders for local library at 15%.

Supervisor Mantegna made a motion to accept the proposal. Seconded by Supervisor Sperratore. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 7. <u>Road Master Report</u>: DOO Versuk presented two options for the clean up of Old Lewis Road at the salt shed. Supervisor Mantegna made a motion to engage OC Landscaping, the less expensive option, at \$825.00. Seconded by Supervisor O'Connell. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 8. <u>Emergency Manager Update:</u> While Emergency Management coordinator, Chuck Freese was not on hand for the meeting. DOO Versuk did provide an update in light of the recent rain events.
- 9. <u>Operations Report</u>: DOO Versuk stated that the 2021 Budgets would be ready for their discussion by Nov. 4.
