- 5. <u>Historical Report:</u> The Supervisors formally acknowledged the decade of service of Kathy Wandersee as Historical Commission Chair by presenting her with a plaque, flowers, and gift card. Scott Steele read the proclamation honoring

- 9. Resolution 2023-02: Ron Woodworth, CPA was appointed to conduct the annual audit. The motion was made by Supervisor O'Connell. Seconded by Supervisor Sperratore. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 10. <u>Resolution 2023-03:</u> Supervisor O'Connell made a motion to appoint the members of the Zoning Hearing Board. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 11. <u>Jenner's Commons/CBRE Extension:</u> Supervisor Sperratore made a motion to accept the Jenner's Commons extension until March 8, 2023. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 12. **863 W. Baltimore Pike:** Penn Township was awarded \$850,000 by the Chester County Commissioners for the purpose of constructing a southern Chester County EOC to house Medic 94. Supervisor O'Connell made a motion to waive the requirement for land development for the site. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0. While all necessary permits will be applied for and obtained, the Supervisors also entertained a motion to waive permit fees. The motion was made by Supervisor Mason. Seconded by Supervisor Ennis. Motion passed 5-0. Supervisor Mantegna further made a motion to instruct Solicitor Sebastian to draw up an agreement regarding rental fees and responsibilities between the township and any user of the 863 property. Seconded by Supervisor O'Connell. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 13. <u>Cell Towers Advertise for sale:</u> Supervisor Mantegna made a motion to advertise the township cell towers for sale. Seconded by Supervisor O'Connell. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
- 14. Other item: Supervisor Mantegna made a motion directing the Solicitor to research and report back on Jenner's Pond Road and Baltimore Pike ownership. Seconded by Supervisor Sperratore. All in favor. Motion passed 5-0.
